Dear Valued Customer:

Escalating conflict in the Middle East continues to disrupt global supply chains and energy markets. These conditions are driving rapid increases in polyethylene resin, along with rising costs across logistics, energy, and raw materials. In response to these unprecedented market conditions, Alliance Films is implementing the following; effective immediately:

All new orders placed on or after April 13, 2026, will reflect an additional 20% increase, aligned with current supplier increases, which are at or above this level.

Contract pricing is suspended due to extreme volatility, supply uncertainty, and ongoing geopolitical disruption. All orders are subject to availability, and Alliance Films reserves the right to allocate supply, limit volumes, or decline orders based on lead times and resin availability. All orders must call for immediate delivery and cannot be restricted in any way. Pricing will be based on market conditions at time of shipment, not order placement.

Additional supplier increases have already been announced for May, and conditions remain fluid.

This is not a discretionary adjustment. It is a direct response to real-time cost escalation and constrained supply across the global resin market. We will continue to monitor the situation, and we will keep you informed to the best of our ability.

The polyethylene market continues to experience significant volatility driven by ongoing global disruptions, particularly in the Middle East. These conditions are impacting supply availability, increasing energy costs, and creating continued upward pressure on resin pricing.

We would like to share an update regarding the evolving situation in the Middle East, its impact on global supply chain, and how these developments are affecting our operating environment. As always, our primary focus remains on continuity of supply, with teams actively managing inventory and coverage across impacted areas. In the past we have successfully overseen several disruptions with similarly broad impacts to the supply chain, such as COVID and other recent supply chain constraints.

Today, the worsening conflict in the Middle East is causing rapid increases in raw material prices, including film, foil, and resin, as well as immediate spikes in logistics costs. Our suppliers are announcing significant price increases with immediate effect in response to the extraordinary changes. The supplier price adjustments that are being passed on to Amcor Flexibles are not currently reflected in the indices, and we will need to recover these costs.

We intend to exercise an early price adjustment effective April 1, 2026 which will include these extraordinary costs.

We are working diligently to minimize the impact wherever possible. With continued focus on the continuity of supply to meet the needs of your business, we are also closely monitoring and analyzing options to shift supply if necessary. Our robust and well-tested business continuity plans are in place to support our footprint, scale and strong supplier relationships.

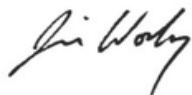

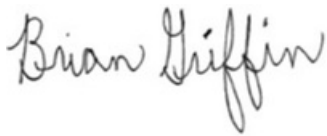

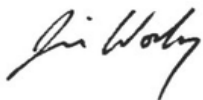

Steep general cost increase for materials and services provided, following supply chain constraints and geopolitical uncertainties – need for price adjustments on products to be delivered to you

We had hoped that 2026 would bring a more stable outlook for the flexible film markets and associated input costs. Unfortunately, the rapidly escalating conflict in Iran and the broader Middle East has created renewed instability across global supply chains and energy markets, resulting in significant cost increases throughout our value chain.

These developments are affecting not only our key raw materials, including polyethylene resins, but also additives, logistics, externally provided services, and energy inputs.

Below, we would like to outline the main factors currently driving cost increases for Trioworld.

Raw materials used in the production of flexible films

Ongoing supply chain disruptions, limited availability of material, challenges in transporting products across global markets, are contributing to substantial price inflation. In March alone, we have seen supplier price increases USD \$0.10, with further unprecedented increases for April ranging from USD \$0.20 to \$0.40 per pound due to the geopolitical situation and associated disruptions. Despite our continued efforts to mitigate these impacts, the reality is that these conditions arose from an Act of War and are completely out of our control.

Energy costs

The conflict in the Middle East has added further pressure to already strained global energy markets, particularly because the region plays a central role in the supply of oil and natural gas. Any escalation in tensions creates uncertainty around production, transport routes, and overall energy availability, which quickly impacts market pricing.

Transport and logistics costs

The current geopolitical situation is affecting global freight flows, shipping routes, and the availability of transport capacity. The price of fuel continues to climb and are approaching record highs.

Our commitment

We remain fully committed to maintaining the high level of service and support you expect from us, and this continues to be one of our highest priorities. However, given the magnitude and persistence of these cost increases, we must implement immediate pricing adjustments, as follows:

- **All open orders as of the end of day, March 31, 2026, will be repriced up by USD \$0.10 per pound.** This increase coincides with the increase announced by our suppliers that took effect on March 1, 2026.
- **All new orders will be processed with a further increase of USD \$0.20 per pound,** reflecting April cost increases and extended leadtimes.
- **All contract pricing arrangements will be suspended until further notice,** due to the inherent and unpredictability of market conditions arising from this **Act of War**.

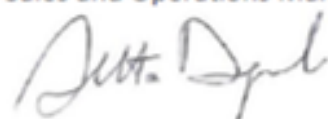
